Comments: Random review of staff files. One staff member's CPR/First Aid certificate is expired. Ensure staff member is not left alone with children until recertified. Please forward proof of enrollment for this staff member by March 31, 2021.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Apr 16, 2021	
Comments: Paint touch ups are required on the walls within the first school aged room. Paint is chipping on both sides of the wall with cut outs and on post.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (a) varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	32(1)(a)	Mar 19, 2021	
Comments: First room (group closest to the door): There is evidence of an art center but this area was depleted during today's inspection. Ensure there is a variety of materials accessible at all times and that these are replenished daily. Some items that could be added include but are not limited to: loose parts, decorative pieces like feathers, beads, pipe cleaners, foam pieces, pom poms, gems etc. Additional pencils, white glue and glue sticks to be added to shelf as well.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Mar 22, 2021	
Comments: Group closest to the door: -The oven door on the play kitchen is broken. To be replaced. -The cardboard brick blocks are torn and showing wear-to be replaced. Group near back of room by windows: -The Lego table is in need of cleaning. Group within room closest to kitchen: -Some doll furniture/accessories are broken and unclean. To be cleaned and replaced.

Comments: Toxic products (bleach/cleaning products) observed within cupboard under sink in the kitchen during today's inspection. These must be locked. Products were moved to locked storage closet today.

Comments: Children's face masks are hanging on the wall side by side and in direct contact with one another. Storage method to be changed immediately in an effort to prevent possible transmission of communicable disease. Discussed some other storage mechanisms with administrator.			

General Comments
<p>Completed renewal inspection today.</p> <p>Children were observed to be engaged in white board drawing, playing card games with their peers and educators, playing mini sticks, engaged in creative art/painting. The children also appeared interested in the light table that had been recently added to the room and were engaged in Lego building within this area. Hand washing routines were observed.</p> <p>Some children were provided with art sets to create bunnies at the art table. Ensure the creative art centers support and provide opportunities for open ended art.</p> <p>Educator reported that the Tim Hortons dramatic play area was an area of interest in the recent past, but this area was not capturing the children's attention today. What else could this be used for? Recommending for educators to further explore the children's interests and add materials to the environment to support this.</p> <p>Ensure non reportable incident reports are being filed within the incident log folders once they have been signed by parent and not within the child's file. Facility does have an incident log folder on site, however, some have been placed within the child's file.</p> <p>Photos of the children have been displayed on the walls, along with the children's art work within both rooms. This is a great way to value the children's work and support further conversations.</p> <p>Some children on site with Emergency plans and Extreme Allergy Plans. Educators will well informed regarding medical conditions and allergies and emergency medications are being stored properly (not locked, but inaccessible to the children).</p>
