Comments: Staff member has completed the online version of CPR/First Aid training. Staff still needs to complete practical component. Certificate to be sent to inspector once complete. Staff can not be alone with child/children until renewed.

Comments: Paint touch ups are still required on the walls within the first school-aged room on the left. Parts of the post have been repainted but some parts still require crack filling repairs and additional paint. Additional repairs and paint are still required on wall with cut outs on both sides. Educators must also ensure that walls located near creative art areas are cleaned/wiped down regularly. There was paint splatter observed in these areas today. (Previous comply by date of April 16/21).

Comments: First room (on side closest to door): Creative art center was still depleted today. Additional materials to be added to this area. Ensure that creative art materials are accessible and replenished daily. See previous inspection report for examples of materials to be added. (Previous comply by date of March 19, 2021).

Comments: First room (closest to door): Oven door on play kitchen is still broken. Another kitchen has been ordered but has not yet arrived. Cardboard brick blocks and torn/showing wear-to be replaced/discarded. Within both rooms: Furniture within doll house is unclean and broken. To be cleaned, broken pieces removed and replaced. (Previous comply by date of March 22, 2021).

<p>Comments: Toxic products (bleach, all purpose cleaner, easy off oven cleaner, etc.) remain in cupboard under sink in kitchen during today's inspection. These must be locked. Products were thrown out and moved to locked storage closet during today's inspection. Discussed options with administrator (facility can add a lock to cupboards under sink or use locked storage closet in hall). (Previous comply by date of March 18, 2021).</p>

<p>Comments: Children's face masks were still being hung on wall within close contact of one another. Advised educator to alter this storage method today. One group is now storing masks within Ziploc bags and the other has increased spacing between the masks hanging up. (Previous comply by date of March 18, 2021).</p>
