General Comments							
A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed during both indoor and outdoor play. While outdoors, children were observed playing on the play equipment, climbing the monkey bars, and playing soccer. Children had their water bottles on an outside table, and educators stated that sunscreen was put on, prior to outside play. Positive child guidance techniques were observed with both groups of children. While inside, the older group were observed playing mini sticks, building Lego, and completing pencil/paper activities. Fresh herbs, veggies, and flowers were observed growing, in flowerpots, on the windowsill. A conversation was had with both Educator and Administrator regarding the room layout. QAM has recommended that educator rearrange room, creating well defined activity centres (Building Centre, Art Centre, Reading Centre, etc.) The younger groups classroom had well defined activity centres - building, dramatic play, art, cozy reading corner, board games, etc. Up-to-date documentation was observed throughout both rooms.
