General Comments									
A renewal inspection occurred today.									
Children were observed in the outside environment playing in the snow. The children made snow angels, had a snowball fight, swung on swings, and put snow on the slides to slide down faster.									
Pod One Room: Educators were observed engaged in drawing and mark making with the children. Children were observed having snack, playing with cars, and creating pictures using different stamps.									
Pod Two Room: Children were observed playing with lego, having snack, and playing catch. Educator shared with Licensing staff that they are new. Licensing staff discussed with the educator ways they could improve the layout of the classroom. For example: Having a discussion with the children to ask what different types of play materials they would like. Removing some tables, adding shelving and carpets to create defined learning centers, and creating a hockey center adding different teams and a score board created by the children.									
Children were observed having an open snack of trail mix and fruit salad. The children were able to eat when they wanted, which allowed children to be able to continue playing until they felt hungry, rather than being asked to eat at a specific time.									
The following records were reviewed: Playground checks, fire drills, and daily attendance sheets.									
All staff files were viewed, and a random review of child files was completed.
