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### General Comments

A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon.

The children were observed outdoors playing on the stationary equipment and engaging in a game of hockey. A transition indoors was observed; once inside, the children were seen eating snack, with handwashing occurring beforehand.

The room was well organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of appropriate materials, books, and toys. Educators shared an ongoing project called "Meet Niska." Niska is going to "soar" across the provinces and territories to help the children learn about the land, cultures, and stories that make Canada unique. At each stop on the map, the children explore that specific province or territory and document what they have learned through various forms of classroom documentation. Educators stated that the children are also interested in dramatic play, forts, gross motor activities, and sensory play.

Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The educators were seen engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision making.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, a random review of five child files, seven staff files, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records.
