COVID-19 Guidance for Early Learning and Childcare Facilities.

Screening was done on the inspectors upon arrival at the neighboring facility. Screening is currently being done at the main facility and then children are brought to respective classrooms. Anyone else arriving is asked to get screened at the main building. Inspector recommends having the APPENDIX D - Daily Log available at the door of both facilities for anyone arriving during the day. Screening questionnaires should also be available on site. Inspector discussed the cleaning logs with the operator. Cleaning is being done and logs are being filed. Inspector discussed having the staff initial after each task has been completed. Operator and staff should see APPENDIX C - CLEANING AND DESINFECTION page 21-27 for cleaning methods used on various toys.
