Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector is informed that the children did not go on any outings since the last inspection, however the administrator is aware that consent must be given by the parent or guardian prior to the outing. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: The inspector observed that the toilet paper dispensers have been repaired. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector is informed that no acetaminophen has been provided since the last inspection, however staff members are aware that they must get the parent or guardian to sign the administration of acetaminophen record. Deficiency is now compliant.			
50(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall inform the parent or guardian of a child involved in an incident on the day the incident takes place and shall ensure that the parent or guardian signs the daily log to confirm their awareness.	50(2)	Nov 10, 2023	Nov 29, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector is informed that no incidents have occurred before today, however staff members are aware that they must get the parent or guardian to sign the incident logs. Deficiency is now compliant.
