Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that 1 of the 2 emergency contacts in 1 of the 14 files verified does not include their address. The child's file must include the name, address, and home and work numbers of at least two people authorized by the child's parent to pick up the child and contact in case of emergency if the parents cannot be reached.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed prescribed medication stored inside a child's bookbag. Medication must be locked and inaccessible to children. During the inspection, an educator placed the medication inside a locked storage area. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
<p>During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed a painting activity, indoor free play, snack time and outdoor free play. The inspector also observed an educator reading to the children in one of the classrooms.</p> <p>During the inspection the ground was snow covered; therefore, the park assessment will be conducted in the spring with a member of the licensing team. The use of the outdoor play structures is not recommended as the ground is frozen and does not provide protective surfacing.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the inspection.</p>
