Comments: As your outdoor play space is not fenced in please remove all materials next to the house. This would include the old bicycle, the adult steel shovel and the big pile of wood that is standing next to your house. There is opportunity for children to get hurt if it ever fell over.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Aug 19, 2019	
Comments: The indoor play space needs to be organized and cleaned. Please ensure floors are swept and washed daily and mats are moved to reach dirt that is underneath them. All dress up clothes, pillows and material curtains in the reading area should be washed frequently.  There were wires dangling by the television in nap room. Observed a baby pulling on the wires. Please ensure that television is secure and no wires are not accessible to children. Television should be wall mounted or put into a different type of television stand as a child could pull it on top of themselves.			

<b>General Comments</b>  Recommending that all material objects be washed, toys cleaned in a javex and water solution, and floors swept and washed thoroughly. There are also some items that need to be removed as detailed in the inspection report.  Children were returning from a trip to ice cream shop. They had lunch, operator read them a story and it was time for nap. A routine has been established with children. Operator engages in conversation with children and guides them gently when necessary.
