## **General Comments**

This report has been completed by Jenelle Hanscom, Nancy Glendenning was also present for inspection. Arrived to perform monitoring inspection, observed children transitioning to quiet time. Operator sat in room with children while they got settled in their nap areas and used calm hushed tones with the children until they all feel asleep.

Materials were organized and plentiful in the activity areas and allowed space for long term projects to be created.

Child attendance records and cleaning checklists were reviewed. Operator should ensure that each item on the daily cleaning list is completed. The floors had a layer of debris during the inspection, more attention is to be given to daily sweep and mopping as children spend much of their time playing and building on the floor of the

home. Childcare licensing staff provided the operator with a list of the approved sanitizers and cleaners that are approved for use.

The operator discussed the use of time out for behaviour guidance, childcare licensing staff clarified that time out is not to be used within licensed childcare and offered alternative positive behaviour guidance such as redirection, modeling and teaching social skills. The operator has taken behaviour guidance courses in the past and was encouraged to review these resources and to avoid reverting to time outs.
