Comments: Items such as empty juice boxes and empty food boxes were observed on floor and cupboards of eating area during the monitoring inspection. Table in eating area was visibly dirty with food debris stuck to it. Tables are to be cleaned and disinfected before and after each use. Floors require sweeping and mopping each day and should not have a buildup of dirt if it is being well maintained. Daily cleaning logs are to be maintained and up to date.	30(3)	Mar 13, 2023	
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies; Comments: Deficiency is now compliant Two gasoline jugs were stored in the outdoor play area of the children. General Comments
<p>Arrived to perform follow up monitoring inspection. Children were engaged in outdoor play upon arrival. Observed children at water play table, in mud kitchen and being pulled around in the wagon by the operator throughout visit. A fence is currently being install surrounding the outdoor play area, one corner remains unfinished. All spare fencing material is to be stored outside of the licensed play area.</p> <p>The operator explained that children are required to be sun screened prior to arrival. Children do not currently bring their own individual sunscreen. Operator was reminded to ask parents to provide sunscreen for children each day and that it is required to be reapplied throughout the day. Children had their water bottles available during outdoor play time.</p> <p>Indoor play space was inspected. More thorough daily cleaning remains a priority. Licensing staff will continue to support operator by checking cleaning logs, providing cleaning guidance and resources.</p>

General Comments

The operator had pleasant interactions with the children in attendance throughout the visit and was observed talking with children on their level and providing help and guidance as needed.
