General Comments						
Purpose of visit was for a regular mointoring inspection. Upon arrival to home all fire exits were clear of snow with no obstructions. Children were engaged with the operator playing a game of BINGO. This version of BINGO used letter recognition and the older children were able to locate most letters without the assistance of the operator. Younger children were given guidance and shown the letters to help them match them to their own playing card. Winter learning stories were posted in the reading area showing that the children were learning about hibernation, migration and adaptation. Art activities were displayed and showed that children engaged in open ended child led art activities. Throughout the inspection positive behaviour guidance was observed. The operator used strategies such as offering choices and made material engaging by showing children how they could play with them. The operator was often on the same level as the children and offering direct engagement with them.
