General Comments
Upon arrival, one of the children opened the door for licensing staff as the children were playing throughout the facility. The first thing that licensing staff noticed was how much more organized and clean the facility was. Clutter was reduced, floors and shelving were clean. The children then cleaned up, washed their hands and had snack. Upon completion, the Operator is now having the children pick up their lunches and put their lunch bags away. Water bottles and children's belongings are being labelled. For the lunches that need to be, they are put into the fridge. Floors are being swept and tables are being sanitized after each meal. The inspection reports for monitoring and renewal inspection are posted. Please be advised that the Operator is only responsible for posting the most recent inspection visits. A fire drill was completed in July and there is a fire extinguisher now located in the eating room of the facility. The Operator has built a program based on the children's interests. This week they are interested in ocean animals. The Operator has once again shown confidence in their ability to build a program based on the NB Curriculum Framework. Please continue to do this as you move forward. Documentary evidence must support the children's learning. The children are now kept out of the room where the napping child sleeps. Cots and bedding needs to be stored properly every day as the cot was still out from the day prior. The administrator put it away at time of visit. The Operator stated that the parent(s) tend to keep their children home when they are sick. Please ensure if children do end up being sent home, that a return after exclusion is filled out when they return to the facility and placed with the potential illness form that is filled out at the time that exclusion occurs from the facility. The outdoor play space was much more organized at the time of visit. It is recommended that the grass be cut as it is getting quite long. I can now recommend facility for licensing.
