- -Late afternoons visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -This was the first monitoring inspection since the increase in spaces, each group clearly has a distinct space which is divided with separators made or fabric each group has its own material and zones that offers a variety and accessible material.
- -No medicine is kept on site
- -Daily routine into the center includes; Outdoor play time is every afternoon when the weather is permitting,

General Comments

snack is served at the recognized hours. Staff confirms that on PD days outdoor playtime occurs twice a day and children eat their lunch at recognized time.

- -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- -Each child needs to have an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child. It was suggested to use a laundry basket for each child for them to store their personal belongings, when a solution is found to store personal belongings, a picture will be sent to licensing staff.

Observations: When arriving at the center children went to wash their hands, sat in the greeting circle attendance was taken. Some had a snack while others who did not eat transitioned into a free play period. Since it is raining outside educators have set up the room with seven and eight different zones on each side such has construction, craft, board games, dramatic play, hockey, giant Tetris Game...etc.
