General Comments -Late afternoon's visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -No acetaminophen is kept on site -Consent form is signed by the parent and kept into the children file when medicine is given. -Medications must at all times be stored in a locked location. If a medication requires refrigeration, the box must be kept in the refrigerator. Measures must be taken to ensure that a locked box or a lock is added to an existing cabinet in the facility. A photo will be sent to the QAM once these measures have been implemented. -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way. -Outdoor material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present and consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play. -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards Observations: When arriving at the center children were into a free play period, some were in the pretend play corner, others were playing mini stick hockey while another group was drawing or playing with Legos. They all changed into their water clothes, the plan it to go outside to play water tag with sponges, then water twister, or duck-duck-geese (drip-drip-drop). When I was leaving, they were all outside playing.
