- -Ensure that the environment reflects the interests of the children by adding materials and props.
- -Set up open ended invitations for the children to explore throughout the day in various interest centers to prompt curiosity and interest.
- -Posting photos of the children and documented evidence (ex: photos of their forts, displaying their art work and projects, etc.) of their learning

Healthy lunch and snacks were served today. The children were heard commenting about how much they enjoyed their hot lunch.

The room behind the front desk is currently being used as a staff room/storage room. This area was cluttered and disorganized today and in need of cleaning and care. Guinea pig and hamster were also being kept within this room today.
