General Comments

Completed follow up to renewal inspection today. Facility has transition from interest based summer camps back to after school care. A work order has been submitted to district regarding the concerns with the outdoor play area (wooden cribbing that is rotting, the fencing in poor repair between preschool and school aged outdoor areas). The bench with protruding bolt on playground has been repaired. Documentation is now being maintained on site to demonstrate that staff are completing daily checks of playground/outdoor play area and monitoring for hazards.

Improvements were noted within storage room where program materials are being kept. This area still requires further attention and organization to ensure that educators have access to materials and equipment at all times. Improvements were also noted within the gym equipment room, but this area still requires further removal of dust, cleaning and organization.

Staff are to ensure that these areas are maintained going forward.

Outdoor play area must be raked daily to ensure adequate surfacing under stationary equipment. Unable to recommend at this time due to outstanding orders for compliance. Another follow up inspection is required.
