Purposeful planning is evident on planning sheets and through invitations that are set up at arrival.</p> <p>Educators and children in Group #6 were observed engaged in a meaningful group conversation in the cozy area about their day at school.</p> <p>Handwashing routines were observed at arrival from school and before snack. Apples and crackers were served for snack this afternoon. Monthly fire drills observed to be documented. New staff file (5) review was completed.</p>
