Comments: During the renewal inspection visit a child was seen taking a medication without parents consent. The medication was not under the child's name and the educators were not aware he had the medication. As per inspectors recommendation the center needs a consent form from the parents giving the child permission to take the medication at the center with the correct instructions. Also the name of the child should be identified on the medication, in its original container with the physician's name, the instructions for use and the time period of use.
