Comments: Quality Assurance monitor noticed that the daily attendance record document that the facility uses was modified from the original document provided by the minister. Operator needs to make sure his staff uses the document that is provided by the minister. Operator can find the document at page 132 of the Operator's manual.

Comments: Quality Assurance monitor observed, in the bathroom, a plate covering an outlet that was loose. Live electrical wires can easily be accessible to children. Indoor area must be maintained safe at all times. Operator fixed the problem while QAM was still on site. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Lysol wipes, lysol desinfectant spray, febreze bottles, shaving cream, nail polish remover and paint cans were found in an area that was accessible to children. All toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children.
