Comments: While on site, the inspector asked the administrator for the Tae Kwon Do programming. The administrator handed out a programming and printed other Tae Kwon Do programming. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The Medicare number was indicated in 7 child's files audited. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: 1 emergency contact out of 2 was missing the complete address in 1 out of 7 child's files audited. The operator must ensure that all child's files all duly completed.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (f) permitting the child to participate in an outing.	27(f)	Nov 03, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the operator indicates that during the summer months, they bring the children's twice a day to different parks around the city by using the facility's transportation. The inspector observed a general consent in the children's files regarding outings away from the facility by foot or with the facility's transportation. However, the inspector was not able to see the consent for special outings signed by the parents/guardians in the child's record. As indicated in the Operator Manual, parents/guardians are asked to sign a separate consent form for field trips when leaving the neighbourhood. The consent should outline the date, time of departure and return, destination and purpose of the trip and any special considerations. Operator must ensure that a written consent is obtained for these outings.

<p>Comments: While on site, the inspector observed dust on the windowsill in the gym, which the administrator cleaned immediately. The two holes were repaired but still in the process to get painted which was leaving the inner parts of the wall exposed. The hole behind the doorknob was not repaired. The operator must ensure that this is repaired in order to have the area maintained clean and safe.</p>

<p>Comments: The inspector had a discussion with the administrator that indicated she asked the parents to label their children's water bottle. Deficiency is now compliant</p>

<p>Comments: The type of care provided was indicated on 2 of the daily incident log audited. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			

**General Comments**

The inspector was on site during free play inside the gym. Some children were playing with magnetic tiles, doing pop-it, and playing freeze dance.

The inspector observed an educator who was reflecting with children on incidents by helping them understand the consequences to their actions and words. The educator used positive interaction to resolve the conflict. The inspector will contact public health regarding concerns on indoor play area in the staircase. A recommendation was given to the administrator regarding the water bottles.

The ratio was respected during the inspection.
