| Comments: The inspector observed that records of emergency evacuations and fire drills had not been completed since April. As per regulatory requirements, emergency evacuation and fire drills must be conducted and documented monthly. | | | |

| <p>The inspector is on site to conduct the renewal inspection.</p> <p>During the visit, the inspector observed children arriving at the facility from school.</p> <p>The inspector observed the children transitioning to the gym area to participate in their Tae Kwon Do class. The inspector also observed children having their afternoon snacks and engaging in free play.</p> <p>A discussion is held with an educator regarding the outdoor play area. The designated outdoor play areas for school-aged children are community parks. As these parks are not part of the licensed facility, they were not inspected during the renewal inspection. It is the operator's responsibility to ensure that these outdoor play areas are safe for children. Any safety concerns must be communicated to the community so that appropriate corrective actions can be taken.</p> <p>The ratio is respected throughout the inspection.</p> |
