General Comments

All three groups had time outside. Some of the children went for a walk with their educators on the path. Large sensory trays were provided in both the indoor and outdoor environments. Inside, the two-year-old room had flowers and orange sand to explore and play with. Outdoors, the trays had soil, shovels, buckets and small pots. Children were dressed according to the rainy weather and were able to fully engage in the gardening activity.

The rooms have lots of recent photos of the children and documentation connecting to the curriculum.

Educators displayed caring and nurturing child guidance. They were engaged with the children on their level and spoke to them using simple words and phrases to expand on their vocabulary.

During lunch, educators sat with the children and assisted them while still allowing them to practice independent eating skills. Age-appropriate cups, chairs, and tables were used to help the children be ready to transition to
