Upon Licensing staff arrival for the renewal inspection, the Junior Infants were napping, and the Senior Infants and Toddlers were outdoors playing.

The outdoor play space had a sand box with scoops and toys, a wooden play climber with slide, sensory walls with colourful pipes and metal bowls, balls, trucks, a swing, and an outdoor chalk board. Educators were engaged with the children and were observed making pretend muffins, giving hugs, and playing in the sandbox. Gentle reminders were heard about being kind to friends and using gentle hands. Later in the morning, the Junior Infants joined for outdoor play.

The indoor space for each classroom was organized and inviting. Children's belongings were neat and tidy in cubbies and learning stories are being posted. Educators in each classroom were observed playing with the children and interacting with them through song and gentle voices. In the Junior Infant room, children were observed sitting in the cozy tent with twinkle lights and playing with shakers, bells, books, and soft toys. The Senior Infant room had a large mirror, family photos, a play kitchen and bins of age-appropriate open-ended material. The Toddler room had art supplies, family photos, books, and bins of labelled material that were in good condition. It is recommended that the flooring in the Toddler room be replaced. The floor was clean although it appeared to be dirty with staining from daily use.

During inspection there was evidence of a daily routine as the transition from outdoor morning play to lunch and then nap time was smooth in each classroom. The infant nap rooms were clear of clutter and calm. The Toddler room had soothing music playing and Educators were observed rubbing backs and providing comfort to those taking time to fall asleep. After nap, afternoon snack was observed as well as free play.

During inspection, child and staff files were verified and all required documentation were present. Monthly fire drills are being conducted and recorded, daily attendance records were in order and the parent board in the main entry was clearly visible.

Licensing recommends for renewal.
