General Comments					

Children were playing throughout the room before lunch. The educators were down on the floor with the children. Some children required extra cuddles and educators met their needs by sitting with them and allowing them to take a break. The educators mentioned that several children are recovering from being sick and are showing tiredness earlier in the day.

Resources are accessible and a good variety for children to choose from. Children would bring resources to educators to play and when one child brought a book to an educator, she started reading asking the children lots of questions and allowing them to point out items on the pages.

Educators encouraged children with their vocabulary and a home connection was made when a child was looking at their family block and pointed out their big brother in their home language which the educator immediately recognized. The educators also repeated the children's names supporting their identities.

Documentation is posted down at the child's level in plastic covers so children can look and touch their photos and revisit their previous play. Art activities are posted on the walls. One educator has prepared a number of photographs of the children throughout the day to create a visual calendar for the door. She has considered children seeing themselves throughout the routine, a very respectful act.

Children's hands and table were washed before lunch. Children received a good serving for lunch with additional helpings provided when children asked, or educators noticed they would like more, prompting more.

Child-staff ratio was met at all times with relief staff covering breaks and lunches.
