I reviewed this program in one of the classrooms and saw lots of wonderful photos of activities that the children have done over the last few weeks. Many of the classrooms were outside or out in the community on filed trips. Covid 19: All surfaces, especially those general surfaces that are frequently touched, such has door knobs, handrails, toys etc should be cleaned and disinfected at least twice daily and when soiled. Toys that have been put in a child's mouth must be cleaned and disinfected, and then rinsed with potable water before being used by another child. A cleaning and disinfection schedule must be in place with clear accountabilities assigned to specific staff. All soiled surfaces should be cleaned before disinfecting, unless otherwise stated on the product.
