General Comments

Children were observed during indoor play and lunchtime.

The two/three-year-old room had circle time. The educator sang and did finger plays. Books were read to the group and educators asked lots of questions to expand on concepts. The room has recently been re-arranged and the environment is calm and inviting. There is a cozy area with a variety of baby dolls. Toys are clean and have been organized in wicker baskets. Furniture and shelving are positioned to allow for specific learning areas such as dramatic play, building and art.

The three/four-year-old room went for a walk on the trail in the morning. Before lunch, children got to choose an instrument from the basket and the educators introduced the concept of beats. Transitions were smooth and educators used the beginning letter of the children's names to call them to their cubbies. "If your name starts with an "A" you can come get your coat and boots on." Ample time was provided for children to independently dress. Educators remained close by to help with zippers.

The room is clean, organized and inviting. Lamps, plants and rugs have been added to the space.

The four/five-year-old room had a story before lunchtime and the educator enthusiastically read the book with fun voices. Lunch was chicken nuggets, rice, and corn. Ketchup was offered to the children and oranges were also served. Educators ensured that each child had their water bottle at the table for a drink. Educators sat with the children and engaged in conversation.

The room is spacious and clean.

All educators were observed to be implementing positive child guidance techniques. They demonstrated respectful communication with the children and kind reminders were used for children to share materials. There were lots of interactions between staff and children and educators took interest in what the children were doing
