General Comments					
The children were all outside this morning using the playground and going for a walk on the trail. The children in the 3-year-old room came in from outside and cleaned up for lunch. The children took a spot on the grass rug and the educator showed them a new toy that arrived and then they were offered a choice of areas to play before lunch. Markers and paper were set up on one table and blocks in two areas. One of the educators invited a child to join her for a mother's day craft. The educators used reminders for children to respect the resources. The children in the 4-year-old room enjoyed lunch and then moved to the mat with a book waiting for everyone to finish. The educators play a meditation for the children allowing them to relax after lunch on rugs, benches, and their coats. After 19 minutes, the educator stopped the audio and asked children where they would like to play offering a large table for animals, plants and natural items, an art area, sand, lego, and playdough. The educators used the time during the meditation to discuss children's interests and do some planning. The group went to the bottle recycling location during earth week and returned bottles so they have some money to offer the children a pizza party. The educators discussed children's favorite pizza places and documented it on a web. The children in the 5-year-old room were engaged in a variety of materials throughout the room after lunch such as blocks, markers and paper, kitchen, links, collage, and imaginary play. One child had gone home sick and documentation was completed. Remember to update attendance records with the reason for absence.
