All seven employee files were verified. - The indoor play material and equipment are maintained safe and clean. - There is no stationary equipment in the outdoor playground. - Observations: <p>3-year-old room: During the visit, the children had a nap, washed their hands and had a snack. The snack was brought from home.</p> <p>3-5-year-old room: The children had a nap, washed their hands, had their snack which was brought from home. The educator was discussing with the child who was not napping. The educators organized a movie for the children for a special activity during carnival week.</p>
