<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Visit completed at the establishment in the afternoon for a monitoring inspection.</li> <li>- During the visit, ratio was respected.</li> <li>- Posted in a visible and prominent place in the establishment are the following documents: The licence, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies and when it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease.</li> <li>- Diaper changing stations are located in the washroom. Each child has an individual storage space for diapers and changing supplies. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non absorbent surface. It is separated from food preparation areas and is located one metre or less from a sink. Children are always supervised during diaper changing routines.</li> <li>- The outdoor play area consists of more than one type of surface to permit different types of play. The outdoor play space is maintained clean and safe for the children. There is no stationary equipment in the outdoor play area.</li> <li>- Toxic products and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children.</li> <li>- Observations: Upon my arrival, the afterschool children were playing outside. Preschool (2–5-year-olds): The children had a nap, ate their snacks (provided by their parents), diaper changing was observed and parent arrivals.</li> <li>• A discussion took place regarding communicable diseases and the outdoor play area. The director presented her plan for the outdoor play space, including the changes and materials she would like to add to enhance the area.</li> </ul>
