During the inspection, the head teacher placed valid copies of the staff member's criminal record/vulnerable sector check and check with Social Development in their file. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that 1 out of the 17 employees' files verified did not have a valid check with Social Development. During the inspection, the head teacher placed a copy of a valid check with Social Development in the employee's file. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed spray chalk and rubbing alcohol in an unlocked storage area. During the inspection, the head teacher placed these products in the locked kitchen. Deficiency is now compliant.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Jun 27, 2023	Jun 27, 2023

<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector overserved that 2 out of the 5 water bottles verified were not labelled with the name of the child. The operator must ensure that water bottles are labelled with the child's name in order to prevent and control the spread of communicable diseases and illness. During the inspection, the head teacher placed the children's names on their bottle. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>			
<p>41(1) A licensed facility at which services are provided to children who wear diapers shall have a sturdy surface that is (a) equipped with rails or safety straps.</p>	<p>41(1)(a)</p>	<p>Jul 07, 2023</p>	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the safety strap is missing from the changing table. The operator must ensure that the changing surface is equipped with rails or a safety strap. The head teacher informed the inspector that the changing table will no longer be used. To ensure proper diaper procedures are followed, the operator will need to have a changing mat available on site when conducting diaper changes.</p>			

<p>General Comments</p>
<p>During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed snack time, lunch, a guided yoga activity, indoor and outdoor free play.</p> <p>The inspector had a discussion with staff members regarding positive child guidance, use of gentle reminders and using positive reinforcement and encouragements. The inspector recommends that staff members re-read section 8.2 on Child Guidance which can be found on page 60 of the Operator Manual.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the inspection.</p>
