Comments: Inspector observes that the protective wooden chips surrounding the stationary equipment would need to replenish to ensure the safety of the children. Operator must ensure the stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth.

Inspector observes children building a tent fort out of a large colorful parachute indoors, outdoor activities that included a group playing in the sandbox and others blowing bubbles, lunch time and the children playing freely indoors such as guided drawing, building blocks and a game of clothes pin tag.
