39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies; Comments: While licensing staff was inspecting the indoor play environment, it was noted that a storage closet was unlocked and ajar which contained a variety of toxic materials such as paint, polyurethane and lacquer.  According to Regulation 39(2), which states: A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies; b) medications; and c) if the licensed facility is located in a family dwelling, firearms.  When this was brought to the attention of the operator, it was determined that a community member was in the church and left the door ajar. When licensing staff attempted to close the door, it was determined that the door is not latching properly. Please ensure this closet containing toxic materials remains locked at all times when the children are present in the licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children. The operator relayed to licensing staff that she will contact the church to have the door fixed.	39(2)(a)	Feb 25, 2022	

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct the licensing inspection visit on February 25th, 2022.</p> <p>Once the children arrived off the bus and in to the building, the children washed their hands and ate their snack. Once they washed up from snack all children went outside to play.</p> <p>The educators in each group were engaging and the children were observed laughing and playing independently and in groups. Positive child guidance was observed and redirection techniques were used during challenging behaviour during the inspection visit.</p> <p>The indoor play environment was very clean.</p> <p>On the day of the licensing renewal visit, the outdoor walkway leading to the stationary equipment was very</p>

slippery as there was a build-up of ice. Please ensure that the walk-way is sanded to reduce any injury from occurring for both educators as well as children.

While licensing staff was observing in the indoor play environment, it was noted that the evacuation route was posted at the exit leading to the playground however, the exit leading up to the church does not have an evacuation route posted. Please ensure there are evacuation routes at all exits to ensure the safety of the children.
