Comments:

Deficiency is now compliant

When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the license renewal inspection, the large room, just inside the entrance, had 21 children sitting down and having lunch and one educator supervising them. This is not in compliance with child-to-staff ratio according to the Early Childhood Services Act. Also, the number of children grouped at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre shall not be more than the number that requires two educators.

Moving forward, if there is one educator supervising children in the larger room at the facility, only 15 children is permitted to be supervised unless a second educator joins the group. Licensing staff suggests moving three children from the smaller group into the larger room and the second educator also join the one educator as to stay within child-to-staff ratio according to the Early Childhood Services Act.

Approximately 15 minutes after I arrived at the licensed facility the operator arrived and was in ratio in the larger classroom and therefore within child-to-staff ratio.

General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the license renewal inspection. The children were eating their lunch. After one group finished up their lunches, they got ready to go outside to play.

Licensing staff only observed the educators using positive child guidance techniques used with the children. The educators were heard encouraging children throughout the inspection.

The children were observed free play activities and playing and also playing at tables where there were invitations of play set up for the children.

While reviewing the educator's files, licensing staff noted two files that had expired documents. When licensing
