General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, all staff members were waiting at the bus stop for the children to arrive. Clipboards with attendance records were brought to the bus stop. Once the bus arrived, children were greeted and lined up with their group. Both groups were planning on spending the afternoon outside. The younger group went inside to wash their hands before returning outside for snack time. A large bin of sunscreen was brought outside, and the children were observed applying sunscreen before engaging in activities.

Outdoor play materials were stored in a large shed and wooden bin. Play materials such as soccer balls, basketballs, chalk and tennis rackets were in good condition. Another bin of materials such as shovels, buckets and trucks was observed by the large sandbox. Some children were observed playing basketball while others climbed a tree and played a game of soccer. One Educator took a small group of children for a nature walk around the building. Ratio was maintained at all times.

Later in the afternoon the children sat with an Educator and drew pictures and spelt their name on the pavement with chalk while others played tennis. On the side of the playground, the children played in a large puddle. Some children brought pans, bowls and found sticks as they collected water, grass and mud to make potions. The Educators were well spread out on the playground, ensuring all children were supervised.

Child and staff records were reviewed on site today. Files were easily accessed and contained all required documents. Only positive child guidance was observed today. The Educators were observed kneeling to be at the child's level when interacting and engaging in the children's activities.
