Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed in both infant rooms that art materials were stored in plastic shelving units with drawers positioned at the children's height. The drawers were secured shut with clear tape, preventing the children from independently accessing the art materials. Art materials must be readily accessible to children and stored on low, open shelves to promote independent choice and engagement in learning activities.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The ratio was respected during the visit. The following elements were verified: - The indoor play area and matériel - The outdoor play area and equipment - Daily routine - Daily activities - If all required documents are posted in a visible place in the facility The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the lunch served today had been switched with yesterday's lunch and that no modifications had been documented. Operators must maintain a current, dated menu plan that provides a record of the food items served each day. Any substitutions must be documented and maintained on file. The kitchen staff updated the menu to reflect the substitutions while the Quality Assurance Monitor was on site. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children playing in the indoor play area. The children were engaged with fall-themed sensory bins containing beans, split peas, and rice. The children were also observed participating in a painting activity, exploring how paint could be applied to paper and to different parts of their body parts. In one classroom, an educator was observed reading a book to the children. Two groups of children

were also observed playing in the gym area, where they used mats and cars that rolled down a wooden ramp. The children were further observed during the transition to lunchtime. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children throughout the visit
