General Comments

Annual Inspection completed.

Today was day five of the transition week for each room. It was evident that educators and the administration team have worked hard to prepare and extensively plan for this week. The rooms were very welcoming and had the children's names displayed along with some family photos. Children's documentation binders are labelled, bulletin boards are ready for new creations and newsletters along with monthly programming are posted.

The team was welcoming as I toured the centre. All rooms were within ratios as I arrived and educators were getting children ready to play outdoors. I observed all groups outdoors. Some of the infants went on a walk in the strollers and the remaining children played in the fenced outdoor play space. All children had water bottles, hats and sweaters/coats brought outdoors. The outdoor play space is well-suited for the younger children in this facility and there are a number of spaces and materials for their use. There are fresh wood chips and a nice paved path for surfaces. There is room for groups to play together and places for more quiet activities. The materials I saw were: instruments, wheel barrows, rings, trucks and cars, plastic animals. One group of senior nursery babies played in their fenced area which is also well-designed for infants. There is a wooden pergola and artificial turf for surfaces. The infants had fun playing on the rockers and with large Duplo blocks. The outdoor spaces were well-maintained and safe.

Prior to lunch, children had some quiet activities. I observed one group listening to music and looking at books. One group was colouring a picture to go with their camping theme. Another group was playing with colorful magnetic shapes at the table.

The educators displayed friendly, nurturing and kind child guidance during my visit and the children were cared for in a loving and compassionate manner. The educators are working hard on bonding with their new children and creating a trusting relationship with them.

The centre was clean and organized and educators work as a team to ensure a smooth operation.
