## **General Comments**

Upon Licensing staff arrival, the children were outdoors. Educators were spread out and actively engaged. The infants were observed playing with balls, sea saws, using the slide and push cars. Kind words of encouragement and cheerful voices were heard. In the large outdoor space, the 2 -year-old children were observed making pizza and pancakes in the mud kitchen, jumping over the tires, and playing with scoops, spoons, balls and outdoor play animals. Educators were playing with the children at their level and were observed offering hugs after a tiny tumble.

The classrooms were tidy and organized. Bins were labelled and were easily accessible for children. Material such as wooden blocks, wooden trains and tracks, loose play pieces, an age-appropriate climbing wedge structure, dolls, trucks and books were in good condition. Family photos and children's artwork were on display in each classroom as well as current learning stories and a monthly planned calendar.

The transition from outdoors to indoors was smooth. Children's belongings were hung up and proper diaper changing procedures and hand washing were observed. Once settled indoors, in the Chipmunks classroom, the Educator prepared a craft with a small plastic container, paint, and marbles. The Educator encouraged the

children to shake the container for a fun art piece which was then hung up to dry. In the Hedgehog room, Educators were observed reading stories on the carpet with children and helping with dress up costumes.

For lunch, the children sat together, either in highchairs or at a low table. Educators offered assistance with packaging and sat with the children. After lunch, tables were cleaned, and chairs were put to the side to prepare for nap. The room was calm, curtains were pulled shut, and soothing music or sounds were played. As a reminder, please do not stack chairs in the play space as they could fall on a child while playing.

After nap and quiet time, cots and blankets were put away and children prepared for afternoon snack. Hand washing was observed.

Child and staff files were verified, and all required documentation was present. The parent board was organized and visible. Allergies were posted in each classroom and monthly fire drills are being conducted.
