The administrator must provide proof by email, or the Quality Assurance Monitor will verify at the next visit that the educators in question have read and signed the statement regarding their obligations under the Act and licensing regulations.

<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site mid-morning to conduct a monitoring inspection and to take measurements of the classrooms and outdoor playground.</p> <p>The following elements were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child guidance - Storage space <p>During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children outdoors engaging in a water fight and playing on a sprinkler pad. Transition times were also observed, along with lunchtime (pizza and salad), followed by children looking at books on their beds before nap time.</p>
