- Children's guidance is done in a positive and respectful way

- Steps or platforms are provided to allow children to reach regular sized toilets or sinks
- Easily accessible space is provided for personal belongings, that space is identified with the child's name and is separated for each child
- Educators observed engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations
- Learning stories posted highlights children's recent learning and interests
- Daily activities includes purposely planned and documented programming such as, time and space for and a free choice of play experiences.
