Comments: The quantity of material in the afterschool room is not sufficient for the number of children present. A variety of material will need to be added. Please refer to Appendix 24 - Equipment and Materials for School-age Children on page 157 of the Operator's Manual for additional information.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Jul 17, 2025	
Comments: Some of the individual space provided for the children's belongings at the entrance are not labelled with the child's name. All individual spaces must be labelled with the child's name.

Comments: An educator left the school age group to have lunch in the adjacent room, leaving 1 educator with 21 children. Another educator, who was floating, joined the afterschool upon request. Deficiency is now compliant.

Both groups washed their hands, prepared for lunch and ate. Once finished, they had a group activity.
