### General Comments

- Midday visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- All children's files have been checked, profile and consent are all completed in due form. A few expiry dates for Medicare number needs to be changed, administrator was made aware of it.
- The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate
- Major incident report was reviewed with the administrator on what incident is considered reportable and which one is not.
- Minor incident reports are maintained in the child's file
- Educators facilitate children's learning by engaging in play and asking open-end questions.
- During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations
- In the entrance and in the preschool room, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, webbing, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted.
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.
- Children's indoor play area is safe and clean
- Containers were added underneath the changing table so diapers and wipes for each child is stored separately
- Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child.
- To store the afterschool personal belongings hangers (identified with their names) are being used, staff says that it is working very well. It was discussed that hangers might not work well with the children's winter clothes; different option was given it will be discussed with the operator.
- Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children

Observations: When arriving at the center children were into a free play period, they were into cars, building with large wooden blocks and drawing. They had snacks and then transitioned into free play this time playing with a light table, sensory bins, drawing and dinosaurs.
