<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>The indoor play environment has a variety of materials accessible to the children. March planning is posted indicating activities the children will participate in throughout the month.</p> <p>Children were observed to spend a significant amount of time waiting for snack to be prepared. It is recommended that an additional toaster be purchased to ensure that on days toast or English muffins are being served, snack may be prepared more quickly. How can you provide activities/ invitations to play that encourage children's engagement while they are waiting?</p> <p>After snack children were observed to engage with materials in the play environment, including creative art, puzzles, and dollhouse. Educators observed to speak kindly and respectfully to the children.</p> <p>Ensure children are provided with adequate space to hang their belongings when they arrive rather than leaving them on the floor.</p>
