General Comments

The indoor play environments were very well organized. The learning centres included blocks, art, reading, dramatic play, games and puzzles, and science to name a few. The educators are using pictures, quote walls, artwork and learning stories to document the children's learning. The educators were engaged with the children and redirected unwanted behaviors when necessary.

The outdoor play area was very disorganized with materials scattered throughout the environment. As per last year's renewal inspection, the areas need to be defined and provide and extension of the indoor play environment. This would mean to provide many of the same opportunities, including space for creative, quiet, pretend, and sensory experiences. In this area, children are encouraged to discover, learn, create, move, manipulate, explore, play by themselves, play with others, and pursue their fields of interest. More materials and accessories for each learning centre needs to be added to the outdoor play space to create learning opportunities for the children. The space also requires at least one more surface to meet regulations.

The administrator advised licensing staff that the children were transported to an outing by the staff. It was stated that in one of the vehicles one of the educator's sisters was present while the educator drove. As the driver is not counted in the child/staff ratio and the sister is not staff; you were required to have another staff in the vehicle with the children.

Please be advised that as for the purposes of section 17 of the Act, the requirements with respect to the transportation of children are as follows:

- (a) if the driver of a motor vehicle is a staff member, he or she shall not be included in the child-to staff ratios calculated under sections 9 and 10
- (b) despite paragraph (a), the driver of a motor vehicle who is a staff member is included in the child-to-staff ratios calculated under sections 9 and 10 if the children transported are school-age children and the route taken is between the licensed facility and the school
- (c) the driver of a motor vehicle and the motor vehicle must be in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act and the regulations under that Act; and (d) the motor vehicle must be equipped with (i) a record of emergency contacts for each child receiving services at the licensed facility, and (ii) a first aid kit that is equipped with the contents prescribed under the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

Operators comply with the Motor Vehicle Act and its regulations regarding driver qualifications, use of infant seat, booster seats and/or seat belts and the registration and inspection of the vehicle.

Driver's abstracts for each educator showing a good driving record (can be obtained at Service New Brunswick) should be kept on file.

It is not recommended for staff members to use their personal vehicles to transport children. However, if doing so, they are to advise their vehicle insurance company.

Files were well organized and information was easily verified by licensing staff.
