General Comments

The children were engaged in a variety of activities during the visit. The two-year-old group were in the outdoor play space then went on a field trip to the splash pad. The 3-year-old group went for a walk to find some puddles to jump and play in. The preschool group was in the school playground pretending they were kayaking in the river, they also went for a walk to watch the excavator move the dirt where the new centre is being built. The afterschool group were playing in the large fort they built in the gym. Some of the afterschool children were sitting at table painting and drawing pictures. The children will draw pictures and take them to the seniors home down the road.

The facility supports independence as seen during lunch time and when the children made their beds up for nap time. Putting the sheets on the matts and getting their blankets ready.

Educators were observed playing games and sitting at the tables with the children, talking to them and asking questions about their day or what they did the night before. Educators asked children what books they wanted to read before nap time or what they wanted to do during quiet time.

There is evidence of purposely planned programming as seen by the learning stories and children's artwork posted on the walls.

The facility was running smoothly during the visit. The children seemed content and familiar with the daily routine of the facility.
