General Comments

- -Visit at the facility for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during today's visit in all groups
- -Easily accessible space is provided for personal belongings, that space is identified with the child's name and is separated for each child.
- -Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children
- -Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when most children receiving services are in attendance weather permitting
- -Rest period meets individual needs of each child
- -Snacks are provided every three hours and lunch is served at a recognized time.
- -Menus are given to a parent at least 3 days prior to serving the food
- -Drinking water is provided throughout the day
- -Infants are always supervised when eating or drinking
- -Infant bottles are labeled with the child's name and stored with a cover, they are only used for the intended child
- -Allergy information is posted in the food preparation area.
- -Children's guidance is done in a positive and respectful way
- -In all rooms, educators observed engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations
- -Learning stories posted highlights children's recent learning and interests
- -Observed in all rooms that literacy is displayed and at the children's level.

Observations:

Infants were exploring with their though tray

Two-year-old were signing and playing instruments and the other group were exploring with puppets and a book Threes and fours were engaged with play doh, instruments and another group were building with large wooden blocks.

Fours were getting ready for their lunch; they were serving themselves and pouring their own milk.
