<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Visit to the center for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -The inspection checklist about the connection with the application of the curriculum framework and the act was given to the administrator; the list was given to all the staff into a meeting. During the monitoring there was a discussion with the staff about items on the list, example and strategies were shared on how they apply requirements into the center. -Each napping child has a cot or nap mat that is appropriate for their height -Each child under 15 months have a designated crib -There is a space of at least 46 cm between rest equipment and all nap equipment is washable and non-absorbent -Each cot is stored so there is no contact with another napping equipment or are disinfected on both sides after each use -Infant bottles are labeled with the child's name and stored with a cover in the refrigerator only used for the intended child -Allergy information on any child is posted in the food preparation area -Drinking water is provided throughout the day. -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children <p>Observations: When arriving at the center I've met two infant groups who were going for a walk. Most groups were out for walks and exploring the neighborhood, The Three-years-old were divided into two groups, one of them went for a walk and the other group were playing with blankets and cushion. The four's were tidying up their room and were getting ready to go play outside, when they came in one little fellow had found peas in the garden and everybody was drawing them. The two-years-old has gotten all ready by putting on their coats, hats and sunscreen and went to play outside. Once all the groups came in, they washed their hands ate lunch and the youngest one got ready for a nap.</p>
