<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Visit to the center for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -The parent is being asked to notify the operator/director the reason why the child is absent, whether it's sickness or another reason. -When a child who becomes ill, he/she is supervised and separated from the other children. That child is to be picked up within one hour of notification to parents. -Management of potential illness forms are completed as required, discussion and explanation with the operator on appendix 11 & 12 in the operator's manual. -Parents are advised when a child has a communicable disease or illness, center does use the notice of illness form (appendix 13, in operator's manual) -The parent handbook contains all information in the parent's role when it comes to managing illness in EIC facilities. - The outdoor space is well maintained; the doorways are cleaned and provide a safe environment for the children to play and explore. -Daily routine into the center includes; Outdoor play time at least once every 4 hour, when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily rest period that meets the children's needs. -Each child has an easily accessible space for personal belongings, which is labeled with the name of the child and used only for the intended child. <p>Observations: Projects were ongoing in each room, in the infant room they had a new fish and were really excited about it, some were exploring with a though tray. Documentation on the wall showed children's interest and newest learning. The two's were exploring black history month, with books and projects. The three's are really interest in engineering, they are into building roads, building and the four's are in making forts with blankets and building stuff with all the open end material that is provided into the room.</p>
