General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today, July 26, 2023, on the School-Age portion of the license only. The half-day preschool is in operation from September to June.

Discussed with educators mixed ratios and the children who have yet to being school (kindergarten), are still at the 0.1 ratio of 4- and 5-year-olds. Educators wanted confirmation that were indeed following child-to-staff ratio

Also discussed choking hazards for children 3 years of age as the center offers a half day preschool program during the school year Recommending changing out the toys at the end of each day so that the children in the half day preschool have age-appropriate items and the school-age children can have age-appropriate items. Some items such as small Lego can be a choking hazard for small children. So having bigger blocks for this age group and regular Lego for school-age children. Discussed storing these bins up on the high shelves and educators can switch these at the end of each program.

Also discussed having books arranged so that the children have easy access to them instead of in a pile in the cozy area. Using the ledge in the downstairs room is place this could be done for this age group.

The children were observed participating in a Zumba class during the inspection as well as playing ball, Lunch,

painting rocks, building with Lego, creating with Pearler beads and making hot air balloons. The children were also observed heading to Quispamsis Elementary School to play on the playground for the afternoon. Discussed outdoor play with educators in regard to the half day preschool program. The Operator's Manual for Full-time and Part-time Early Learning and Childcare states:

"Part-time programs operating less than 4 hours are required to have outdoor play time of at least half an hour."
