General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection occurred on the school-age portion of the license only due to the preschool being closed for the summer months.</p> <p>Upon arrival at the childcare facility, Inspector observed that the two groups of children were heading to Quispamsis Elementary School to play on the playground and adjacent field. Inspector observed the children playing on the playground's swings, climbers, playing basketball and baseball with their peers.</p> <p>Educators were observed, by the Inspector, positioning themselves throughout the play area so that the children were always within their sight.</p> <p>At lunch time the children returned to the childcare facility for lunch. Children were observed washing their hands after outside play and having lunch with their peers. Educators were observed sitting with the children during this time.</p> <p>During their time inside, the children were observed playing with Lego, having a game a chess, playing hairdresser, building with blocks, drawing, playing a game called "Imposter" with their educator.</p>

General Comments

Administrator indicated that the children sometimes would go on field trips to the "spider park," splash pad and school playground.

The educators were planning an outing for the children in the afternoon of the renewal inspection to Foodland for popsicles, pending the weather.

Educators were observed, during the inspection, engaged with the children in their games, play, and conversations. Using positive child guidance techniques and speaking kindly and appropriately to them.

All staff files were reviewed, and one staff file requires First Aid. A random review of 15 children's files occurred, and all were verified complete with required information.
